**Introduction and reception of  
foreign laws: Legal technical  
assistance projects in Viet Nam**

The Vietnamese law has been bearing a lot of influences in the course of its evolution. That might make it difficult to be apprehended by foreign legal researchers: the romano-germanic basis of the colonial legislative enterprise in the one period; the marxist-leninist ideology, the traditional social order inspired of Confucianism and the religious belief in the others. These influences have contributed in the definition of the conditions and the context of the development of the current Vietnamese legal system.

The Vietnamese modern legislation was inaugurated after the Revolution of August 1945, revolution which results in the foundation of a socialist State in Vietnam. In the beginning, the Vietnamese socialist legislation had been profoundly impregnated with the soviet legal system,
