What are the objectives of the programme?

In 2007 the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) and the Asian Institute of Technology (AIT) have agreed to strengthen national and institutional capacity of priority countries in South East Asia, namely Cambodia, Lao PDR, Myanmar and Vietnam through the offering of the DAAD-AIT scholarships. The scholarships are available in the following fields of study offered at AIT:

- Agricultural Systems and Engineering,
- Aquaculture and Aquatic Resources Management,
- Energy,
- Environmental Engineering and Management,
- Food Engineering and Bioprocess Technology,
- Gender and Development Studies,
- Natural Resources Management,
- Pulp and Paper Technology,
- Regional and Rural Development Planning,
- Urban Environmental Management,
- Clearer Production,
- Integrated Tropical Coastal Zone Management,
- Integrated Watershed Development and Management,
- Modeling Tools in Environmental Resources and Management,
- Disaster Preparedness, Mitigation and Management.

Who can apply?

Candidates should be not more than 28 years of age when applying. Both excellent academic performance and a very good command of English (TOEFL or IELTS) are essential.

Target group

Highly qualified graduates from Cambodia, Lao PDR, Myanmar and Vietnam.

What is fundable?

The scholarship covers tuition and other academic fees and living allowances for a 22-month programme.

Application and Selection procedure

Prospective applicants should apply directly to AIT. For further details visit the AIT website at www.ait.ac.th.

Successful candidates will be preselected by AIT Bangkok, the final decision on a DAAD scholarship will be made by DAAD in Bonn/Germany in June of each year. Master's degree courses start in August of each year
